The proposed 2024 Camden Redevelopment Agency (CRA) budget reflects an overall increase of 29.9% (\$558,238.00) as compared to the FY 2023 adopted budget year.

The FY 2024 budget reflects a variance from the FY 2023 adopted budget in three (2) Operating Revenue line items, specifically, Project Administrative/Redevelopment Fees, Land Sales, and Other Receivables. CRA is positively impacted as local/regional economies are recovering in this post-COVID period, despite challenges of intermittent rising interest rates, more stringent underwriting for financing and construction costs.

Project Administration/Redevelopment Fees - increase of 105.5% (\$317,253.00). This increase can be attributed to expected closings of several land transactions within the budget year and/or collecting negotiated fees for extensions of time.

Land Sales – increased 24.3% (\$263,374.00) in closing transactions from the FY2023 from the FY 2023 budget year. Over forty state programs are now in place to incentivize economic development activity. CRA expects these interventions to offset rising interest rates and construction costs and increase economic/development activity in the future budget year. (See Attachment #1)

Other Receivables – decreased 18.6% from the prior adopted FY 2023 budget year. This reflects a reduction in the number of reimbursements from various EPA grants. (See Attachment #1).see attachments for more
