**Public Comments**

Commissioner Hagamin opened the Public Comments portion of the meeting.

With regard to Resolution 10-03-12F, Mr. Colandus "Kelly" Francis of the Camden NAACP asked: What properties are involved? Are the properties scattered or townhomes? Ms. Simpson noted they are scattered sites. He also inquired about whether the project entails renovations or restorations? Ms. Simpson noted the project has six renovations and 24 new construction sites, all of which are located in Cooper Plaza.

Regarding Resolution 10-03-12G, Mr. Francis asked: Is the loan for reconstruction or rehabs? Ms. Simpson reported the loan will be for rehabilitation of three properties owned by St. Joseph's Carpenter Society.

Regarding Resolution 10-03-12H, Mr. Francis posed three questions: Is the money from the municipal budget? Was it held in escrow since the end of the last fiscal year? Is there a specific use intended for the funds? City Finance Director Glynn Jones affirmed the \$250,000 loan to CRA will be drawn from the City's budget ending June 30, 2012. Mr. Asselta added, the funds are not earmarked for specific purposes; they will provide a cushion for cash flow. He also noted slowed timing on project income made this action necessary. The hope is CRA will not need to use the funds.

There were no further comments or questions.

Commissioner Hagamin took the opportunity to thank CRA staff and Executive Director Johnson for their hard work. He noted: the City of Camden thanks CRA, too.
