WHEREAS, the City of Camden Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") is charged with the duty of redevelopment throughout the City of Camden; and

**WHEREAS**, the CRA is in the process of conducting a Remedial Investigation of the CRA-owned land on the Camden Waterfront which is designated as Block 81.06 Lots 3.01 and 3.02 and Block 80 Lot 5 ("Site"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Site is proposed to be redeveloped as Mixed Waterfront Zone consistent with the Camden Downtown Redevelopment Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the CRA previously accepted by Resolution 04-26-12E a Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund ("HDSRF") grant to conduct the Remedial Investigation of the Site and the groundwater associated with the Site; and

**WHEREAS**, the field work has been concluded and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP") now requires the preparation of a Remedial Investigation Report ("RIR") and a Remedial Action Workplan ("RAR") to close out the investigation phase; and

**WHEREAS**, the DEP has reviewed the CRA's proposal and has found it to be technically eligible for a HDSRF grant;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of the City of Camden Redevelopment Agency that the Executive Director of the Agency, is hereby authorized to accept a grant in the amount of not to exceed \$42,454.00 from the Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund for a Remedial Investigation of the Camden Waterfront-East Village Site; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Executive Director or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions and execute all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
