#### **Resolution Title:**

Resolution Authorizing a Professional Services Agreement with Pennoni Associates, Inc. for Environmental Risk Assessment Services in Connection with the Remediation of the Former RCA Building 8 Located on Block 72 Lot 1 of the City of Camden Tax Map in an Amount Not to Exceed \$50,666.00

#### **Project Summary:**

- The former RCA Building 8 is located at the SE corner of Front and Cooper Streets in the Camden Downtown Redevelopment.
- The CRA received a US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfields Cleanup Grant to partially fund the remediation of the Former RCA Building 8.
- The CRA requires the services of an environmental firm with specialized expertise in environmental risk assessment to assess the feasibility of reusing the building for non-residential purposes.

## **Purpose of Resolution:**

Authorize a professional services agreement.

WHEREAS, the City of Camden Redevelopment Agency (CRA) is charged with the duty of redevelopment throughout the City of Camden; and

WHEREAS, the CRA is the owner of property, located at 100 Cooper Street in the Camden Downtown Redevelopment Area and designated as Block 72 Lot 1 on the City of Camden Tax Map and also known as the Former RCA Building 8 (the "Site"); and

WHEREAS, the CRA requires an Environmental Risk Assessment to assess the feasibility of remediating and redeveloping the Site for no-residential uses; and

WHEREAS, in order to procure these services the CRA advertised and posted on its website a Request for Proposals entitled, "Professional Environmental Services Risk Assessment Former RCA Facility Building 8" dated September 30, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, Pennoni Associates, Inc. was determined to be the most responsive firm and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A 11-5((1) (a) (i)) the CRA desires to execute a professional services agreement with Pennoni Associates, Inc. for a fixed fee; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available from the CRA's EPA Building 8 Brownfield Cleanup Grant and the proposed Professional Services are eligible activities under that grant.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of the City of Camden Redevelopment Agency, that the Interim Executive Director, a duly authorized representative of the Agency, is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate and enter into a professional services agreement with Pennoni Associates, Inc. to conduct an Environmental Risk Assessment in connection with the Former RCA Building 8 remediation for an amount not to exceed \$50,666.00 payable on a per task basis; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Interim Executive Director, or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions and execute all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
